Tuition & Other Fees: Tuition for the 2017-2018 school year has increased by \$250.00 for both in-parish and out of parish. This equates to \$25 a month over the school year. The registration fee is \$300 per family.

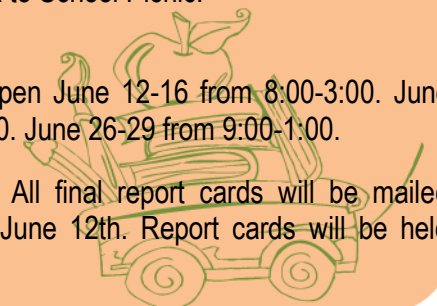
